

DRINKING WATER PROBLEM CORRECTED

Customers of the Charlestown Utility Board were notified on 11/03/2022 of a problem with our drinking water and were advised to boil water. We are pleased to report that the problem has been corrected and it is no longer necessary to boil water before use. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused and thank you for your patience.

Bacteriological sampling has been conducted in the affected areas of the line breakage on Willow Spring Drive and Prospect Ave and have verified that the system remains free from contamination.
